Feedback to evaluate COSME programme

- Public consultation for stakeholders and SMEs on COSME, the EU programme for the competitiveness of enterprises and small and medium-sized enterprises that ran from 2014 to 2020 with a budget of 2.3 billion EUR
- <u>Consultation</u> open until **18 September 2023**
- COSME supported the Enterprise Europe Network, Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs, projects for tourism and social economy, the IPR Help desks, and projects for cluster internationalisation and cluster excellence
- The results will help the EC to improve future support programmes for SMEs



20 Euroclusters work on concrete initiatives in specific industrial ecosystems



What are the Euroclusters? In numbers ...

- On 1 of September 2022, 30 Euroclusters have been launched: they are composed of 171 partners overall and cover 23 different countries (of which 22 are EU Member States) and all <u>14 industrial</u> <u>ecosystems</u>.
- **Duration**: Projects' implementation range from 24 to 36 months.
- **Total budget** for the first Euroclusters call: **42 million EUR** (from the Single Market Programme)
- Cascading calls for SMEs: At least 75 % (around 32 million EUR) of the grant must go directly to SMEs



Cascading calls: What is there for SMEs?

- Between February and June 2023, **21** out of the 30 SMP Euroclusters awarded projects **published 32 cascading calls** to financially support SMEs.
- In total these first calls will award around 17 million euro (more than 50% of the 31.5 million expected in total) to around 1500 estimated SMEs.
- 18 calls have been closed by now (with deadlines between 21 April and 27 June)
- 14 are still ongoing (3 closing within a week between 30 June and 2 July).
- More FSTP Calls are expected to be published soon.





'Innovate to transform' support for SME's sustainability transition

- Projects are expected to contribute to the following outcomes:
 - Support **objectives** of the European Green Deal and of the EU SME Strategy for a sustainable and digital Europe;
 - Increased resilience of SMEs, by fostering technological and social innovation in SMEs to support their transition to more sustainable business models and more resource-efficient and circular processes and infrastructures;
 - Increased competitive sustainability of SMEs through the uptake of advanced technologies;
 - Stronger **innovation support ecosystems** supporting the green, social and economic transition of SMEs, by leveraging synergies between existing EU networks and SME support initiatives
- This action will consist in advisory services and financial support in the form of 'third party financing'
- Opening date: 19 September 2023

Accelerating uptake through open proposals for advanced SME innovation

- Projects' results are expected to contribute to some or all of the following outcomes:
 - Development of a **mature technological solution a**ddressing EU security policy priorities in the areas addressed by the Cluster 3 work programme.
 - Facilitated **access to civil security market** for small and medium innovators and enhanced links between suppliers and public buyers;
 - Improved **cooperation between public buyers and small supply market actors** for a swifter uptake of innovation in response to short to mid-term needs;
 - **Stronger partnerships** between small and medium EU security industry and technology actors to ensure the sustainability of the EU innovation capacity in the civil security domain and increase technological sovereignty of the EU in critical security areas.

Implementing co-funded action plans for connected regional innovation valleys

- This action is intended to **create connected regional innovation valleys** across the European Union (EU), involving regions with lower innovation performances, by building on strategic areas of regional strength and specialisation (defined in their smart specialisation strategies), in support of key EU priorities.
- The aim is to foster the creation of efficient, open, inclusive and interconnected European innovation ecosystems in line with the New European Innovation Agenda, notably in **thematic/technological areas** (including deep tech) that will be critical for EU value chains.
- The topic is primarily focused on the regional aspects of innovation and targeted at national and/or regional innovation authorities. Other relevant entities should participate in the consortia as **associated partners** (such as research institutions, public authorities, universities, companies, clusters, innovation intermediaries, etc.).
- Deadline: 17 October 2023
