OBJECTIVES

The European Commission (EC) will organise the **EU – Singapore Matchmaking Event** as part of [Singapore Week of Innovation & Technology \(SWITCH\)](#) and [Agri-Food Tech Expo Asia 2023](#), both will be held on 31 October – 2 November 2023.

The **EU – Singapore Matchmaking Event** itself will take place on-site in Singapore on 30 October – 1 November 2023.

The event will be jointly organised by the European Commission and Enterprise Singapore (ESG) - with the support of the EU Delegation to Singapore and the Singapore Ministry of Trade and Industry and facilitated by the European Cluster Collaboration Platform (ECCP) and the Enterprise Europe Network (EEN).

The **EU – Singapore Matchmaking Event** will bring together cluster organisations, SMEs, Start-Ups and European Industry Associations from the European Union (EU), non-EU COSME countries, and Singapore. It will provide participants an excellent chance to promote Cluster to Cluster (C2C), Cluster to Business (C2B), and Business to Business (B2B) collaborations.

The overall objective of the event is to promote the exchange of information and provide networking opportunities for European cluster organisations and their members with counterparts from Singapore, particularly in the fields of Agri-food, Health Care and Biomedical Tech, Digital Tech, Smart Cities and Urban Solutions, Advanced Manufacturing, Green Tech.

The objectives for the participants include:

- Strengthening EU-Singapore cluster cooperation for the benefit of their members, including a seminar, a cluster matchmaking event, and site visits.
- Identifying potential areas of common interest for cooperation and synergies, in terms of the sectoral, value chain, and market focus of their SMEs and other companies.
- Improving, through clusters, the EU-Singapore industry and academia-industry collaboration in research, development, and innovation. For its members, the clusters will identify possible areas of RDI collaboration (academia, research organisations, industries...).

This call for Expression of Interest is launched to identify small and medium-sized enterprises (including Start-ups) and European Industry Associations from EU (and non-EU COSME) countries (please see section “Who can participate” below) who are willing and committed to participate in the EU-Singapore Matchmaking Event.

By submitting an expression of interest in response to this call, you are indicating your acceptance of the call's terms.

This call is published on the ECCP website. Expressions of interest to participate in this event must be **submitted electronically by 12 July (Wednesday) 2023, 23:59 Brussels time – first cut-off date and 5 September (Tuesday) 2023, 23:59 Brussels time – second cut-off date (the second cut-off date will be available in case of still available places after the first round of evaluation after the first cut-off date – see more details in section *Selection process* below) through:**

CONTEXT OF THE INITIATIVE

The Event will take place in the context of the ECCP activities. The European Commission facilitates international cluster cooperation through the ECCP including the organisation of specific cluster matchmaking events and policy development actions. The objective is to support cluster organisations to develop partnerships and business cooperation in European and global markets, for the benefit of their members, especially of SMEs. The events are currently funded under the EU Competitiveness of Enterprises and SMEs Programme (COSME).

The ECCP provides a visible framework for this matchmaking event and for subsequent events. As the cornerstone of the European strategy in support of SMEs' internationalisation through clusters, the ECCP provides a wide range of information and services to facilitate the interaction between clusters not only within Europe, but also with international partners.



ACTIVITIES & AGENDA

The EU – Singapore Matchmaking Event will include the following activities:

- Advanced manufacturing
- Green tech

PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible:

- The applicant must be an SME according to the [SME definition](#) of the EU (including a Start-Up) or European Industry Association
- The applicant must be a legal entity established in a European Union Member State or other COSME country. See list of non-EU participants in the COSME programme here: <https://ec.europa.eu/docsroom/documents/39579>



SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications will be evaluated qualitatively using the following selection criteria:

- Willingness and capacity to maximise matchmaking opportunities via participation in this event, based on a detailed description of the sort of partnership sought by the applicant and the likelihood of developing practical collaboration because of the Event. This indication of interest in cooperating must be clearly articulated as responses to the questions in the application form.
- Activities in the target sectors.
- Operating beyond the stated fields should extensively motivate the argument for their application to a reserve list that will be determined in due time.
- The desire and capacity to collaborate more closely with Singaporean SMEs (including Start-Ups), Industry Associations and Network Organisations in order to better global competitiveness via collaborative efforts.

Organisations that have not participated before in the ECCP matchmaking events are encouraged to apply.

The selection of applications will be based on the afore mentioned criteria and information provided in the application form; in cases of equal merit, the balanced geographical and sector coverage of the EU and COSME participating countries will be considered. Furthermore, in cases of equal merit, organisations participating for the first time at the ECCP matchmaking event will have priority.

The organisers reserve the right to ask for additional information from the applicants, if necessary.

Attendance at the seminar, the matchmaking event, the debriefing session, and the site visits are all compulsory.

Organisations selected to participate in the Event must send a commitment e-mail agreeing to attend the on-site seminar, conduct at least four matching meetings, and engage in the final 30-minute debriefing session.

SELECTION PROCESS

This Call for Expression of Interest has two cut-off dates (deadlines):

1. 12 July 2023, 23:59 Brussels time and
2. 5 September 2023, 23:59 Brussels time (the second cut-off date will be available in case of still available places after the first round of evaluation after the first cut-off date).

First cut-off

Applicants will receive a notification whether their application is selected, put on the reserve list or rejected within two weeks after the first cut-off date. Applications on the reserve list may be edited and resubmitted until the second cut-off date – the last submitted application will be considered in the evaluation.

Second cut-off

Applicants will receive a notification whether their application is selected or rejected within two weeks after the second cut-off date.



Applicants that are not selected may participate at their own cost if they fulfil the eligibility criteria of this call.

Applications on the reserve list of the first cut-off will be evaluated together with the applications received by the second cut-off date.

In case of available places, applications are accepted until 23 October 2023, 23:59 Brussels time at the latest.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Expressions of interest should be submitted by 23 October 2023, 23:59 Brussels time through the following link:

- A fully completed questionnaire on the profile of the organisation.

However, no funding is offered for SMEs (including Start-Ups) and European Industry Associations to cover any travel and accommodation costs related to participation at the event.

To take the maximum of your participation and benefit from all planned pre-event activities and meetings available during the EU-Singapore Matchmaking Event, we encourage you to send your Expression of Interest at your earliest possible and avoid last minute registrations.
