TRANSFORMER (2022-2024) is aiming to contribute to reaching the climate goals through Transition Super Labs.


A Transition Super Lab (TSL) is a collaborative governance arrangement based on adapted and enhanced living lab methodologies. In this co-creative approach, all relevant stakeholders from the quadruple helix implement a portfolio of connected solutions for climate neutrality.

We consider entire regions as living labs, with experimentation for the purpose of transformation.
