GREEN TRANSITION

The European Green Deal is Europe's new growth strategy.

At the heart of it is the goal of becoming the world's **first climate-neutral continent** by 2050.



GLOBAL COMPETITIVENESS

The right conditions are needed for entrepreneurs to turn their ideas into products and services and for companies of all sizes to thrive and

The EU must leverage the impact, the size and the integration of its single market to make its voice count in the world and **set global standards**.



DIGITAL TRANSITION

Digital technologies are changing the face of industry and the way we do business.

They allow **economic players** to be more proactive, provide workers with new skills and support the decarbonisation of our economy.

Cascade funding / FSTP Calls to SMEs



Between February and October 2023, all 30 SMP Euroclusters awarded at least 1 call. In total they **published 55 cascading calls** to financially support SMEs. More FSTP Calls are expected to be published soon.

In total these first calls will award around **26.7 million euro** (out of the 31.5 million expected in total) to **almost 2000 estimated SMEs**.

Half of them are closed but half is still open

FSTP supports e.g. participation in networking and marketing activities; advisory services; collaboration pilot projects; travel grants; prototyping/ demonstrations actions; development of new products/ processes to be launched on the market; etc.

Opportunities for SMEs: Calls from Euroclusters



- AIBC: Open Call for digitalisation services and product development targeted at European SMEs from the manufacturing, mobility, logistics and energy sectors, working on the AI & BC technologies and/or interested in adopting AI & BC solutions; deadline 16 January 2024
- B-Resilient: Acceleration lump sums targets food processing and producing SMEs intending to optimise their use of biomass via digital and sustainable tool solutions; deadline 1 February 2024
- <u>CircInWater</u>: Knowledge lump sum is willing to boost SMEs' development or growth by facilitating access to external training or consultancy services; meant for an individual SME that is offering water-smart solutions, especially for the agrifood & energy-intensive industries; deadline 2 October 2024
- <u>E-Boost:</u> Five calls to identify product innovations to reduce dependency on critical inputs and technologies in the E- BOOST value chains, to introduce new-to-firm products or services, and to engage actors from regions with different levels of economic development; targets are SMEs from the **mobility** ecosystem
- <u>ELBE</u>: Financial support for training on "Sustainability & Digitalization", "Sustainable Business, with focus on general ESG issues, UN
 Sustainability goals and a materiality analysis", "<u>Factlines</u> Platform for ESG reporting"; deadline 31 December 2023
- <u>EU Rural Tourism</u>: 2nd open call for rural tourism SMEs to improve their digital, green and social maturity, skills, and capacities;
 deadline 16 January 2024
- FRIEND CCI: 2nd Open Call for project proposals dedicated to SMEs to reinforce innovation and internationalisation in Cultural
 and Creative Industries; deadline 14 January 2024
- <u>FRIEND CCI</u>: Call for **providers** offering solutions in **digitalisation**, **greening**, **and internationalisation** to collaborate with **Creative** and **Cultural** SMEs for the realization of funded projects; deadline 1 August 2025
- GEMSTONE: Financial support for training related to Green Manufacturing; deadline 31 December 2024

Opportunities for SMEs: Calls from Euroclusters



- INGENIOUS: Internationalisation grant for SMEs operating in energy-intensive industries to develop activities related to Africa, Asia, North America and Latin America; deadline 30 September 2024
- INGENIOUS: Training grants to help SMEs improve their digital skills, green transition, resilience preparedness and reskilling and upskilling of the workforce; deadline 14 February 2025
- METASTARS; Call for innovation services for green technology development, digitalisation, upskilling and reskilling,
 internationalisation, and information security systems for SMEs from the aeronautics, space, defence and ICT sectors; deadline 31
 December 2023
- <u>PIMAP4Sustainability</u>: Support for upskilling and reskilling projects for photonics, advanced materials, advanced manufacturing, aerospace, metalworking and industrial production SMEs; deadline 31 December 2023, 29 February 2024, 30 April 2024
- RESIST; 2nd Innovation Open Call for improved technologies and processes in production in the Automotive Mobility Transport
 ecosystem; deadline 12 December 2024
- RESIST: Networking and marketing FSTP for SMEs from the Automotive Mobility Transport ecosystem; deadline 20
 December 2024
- RESIST: Internationalisation FSTP for activities in target markets; deadline 20 December 2024
- RESIST: Coaching and mentoring for assessment and feasibility services; deadline 1 November 2024
- <u>SILEO</u>: Open Call for **Talent Placement Projects** aimed to support lighting and furniture SMEs to attract professionals and young graduates; 30 January 2024

- (outside FSTP)
 Webinar events explaining e.g. mobility trends, to enhance cooperation between industrial ecosystems and SMEs.
- **Mapping** of entities (SMEs and start-ups, research organizations, training agencies, innovation partners, clusters, business associations, etc.) to act as the ground on which all contents and activities managed in the Eurocluster will be shared.
- **Training workshops** designed (for SMEs and clusters managers/ staff) and to be delivered on the topics: circular economy, digitalization, upskilling and shortage of labour force, cluster management skills, interaction and collaboration among clusters.
- Matchmaking events, promoting upcoming FSTP Calls, and enabling SMEs to find partners to apply with and foster collaboration between them.
- Analysis of existing critical inputs / supplies / technologies to better understand challenges that SMEs are facing in their specific market.


