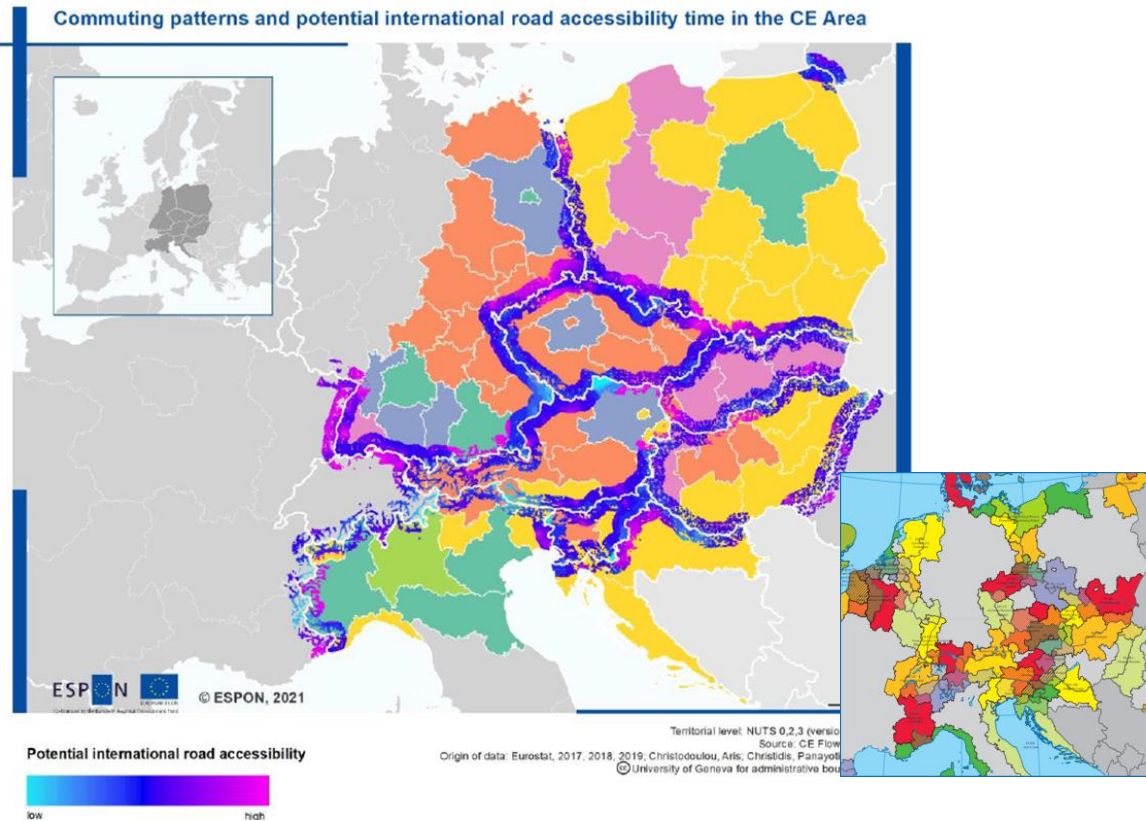
Call for „small places“



➤ Decision of Monitoring Committee on 2nd call proposals as well as shape and number of future calls expected on 31st January-1st February 2024

- Call addressed and concentrated on rural and peripheral areas
- Need for counteracting the urban-rural divide and fostering territorial cohesion in CE populations and economies
- Engaging local population and delivering solutions to local communities through small-scale projects.

Capitalisation Call – capitalisation through co-ordination



- Central Europe is crossed by 15 inner borders that hamper functional flows. Existence of non-formal borders between regions and governance levels
- Synergies and co-ordination between transnational and cross-border projects

Analysis of needs and potentials for the call and identification of topics - through consultations with national, regional and CBC stakeholders.
