SITE VISITS

Site visit 1

Tech: Study visit at <u>Ublox</u> company connected to the priority area of tech, the visit led by the cluster <u>Mobile Heights</u>. Ublox develops some of the world's leading IoT communication modules, GNSS modules, chips, and services - all supporting the industrial, automotive, and consumer markets. At the study visit, they will talk about some of their newest developments.

Site visit 2

Advanced Materials and Manufacturing: Study visit at <u>Duni</u> company connected to the priority area of Advanced Materials and Manufacturing, the visit led by the cluster <u>Packbridge</u>. Duni AB is a Swedish industrial company that manufactures products for table setting and serving. The company has 2,400 employees in 24 countries. The head office is located in Malmö. At the study visit Duni will share their sustainability journey from disposable items to a company with a circular orientation.

Site visit 3

Food - Skåne Food Innovation Network and Packbridge: Study visit at Orkla company connected to the priority area of Food, the visit led by the cluster Livsmedelsakademin. Orkla is a branded consumer goods company with a major focus on promoting sustainable development within the industry. At this study visit, you will get a deep dive into their work and try some of their new samples!



About Media Evolution



Media Evolution started in 2008 as a joint initiative between the private sector, the academy and the public sector to promote the conditions for growth and innovation in the media industries. TRAVEL INFORMATION

When travelling to Malmö by plane, it's easier to fly to Copenhagen airport. It's only 20 minutes away by train. Trains run 24/7. Once you have travelled over the Öresund Bridge to Malmö Central Station, the walk to Media Evolution is only a few minutes.

There is also an airport in Malmö (Sturup), but it takes a bit longer to get from the airport to the city center/Media Evolution. From the airport, you go by airport-shuttle buses that leave every once in an hour.

INFORMATION ABOUT MALMÖ + ACCOMMODATION

The third-largest city in Sweden, Malmö is thoroughly modern, with cuttingedge design and architecture, a booming tech sector, and four Michelinstarred restaurants in a relatively tiny metro area of just 728,000.

The city proper of Malmö has just 316,000 year-round residents, yet people who visit Malmö are often struck by how this city boasts one of the most unabashedly international cultures they've ever seen, rivalling that of most other Nordic metropolises.

People who visit Malmö are equally drawn to the cobblestone streets of the quaint, 15th-century city centre and the funky, experimental restaurants and clubs that are scattered throughout the district.
