The Single Market - corner stone of the European Union

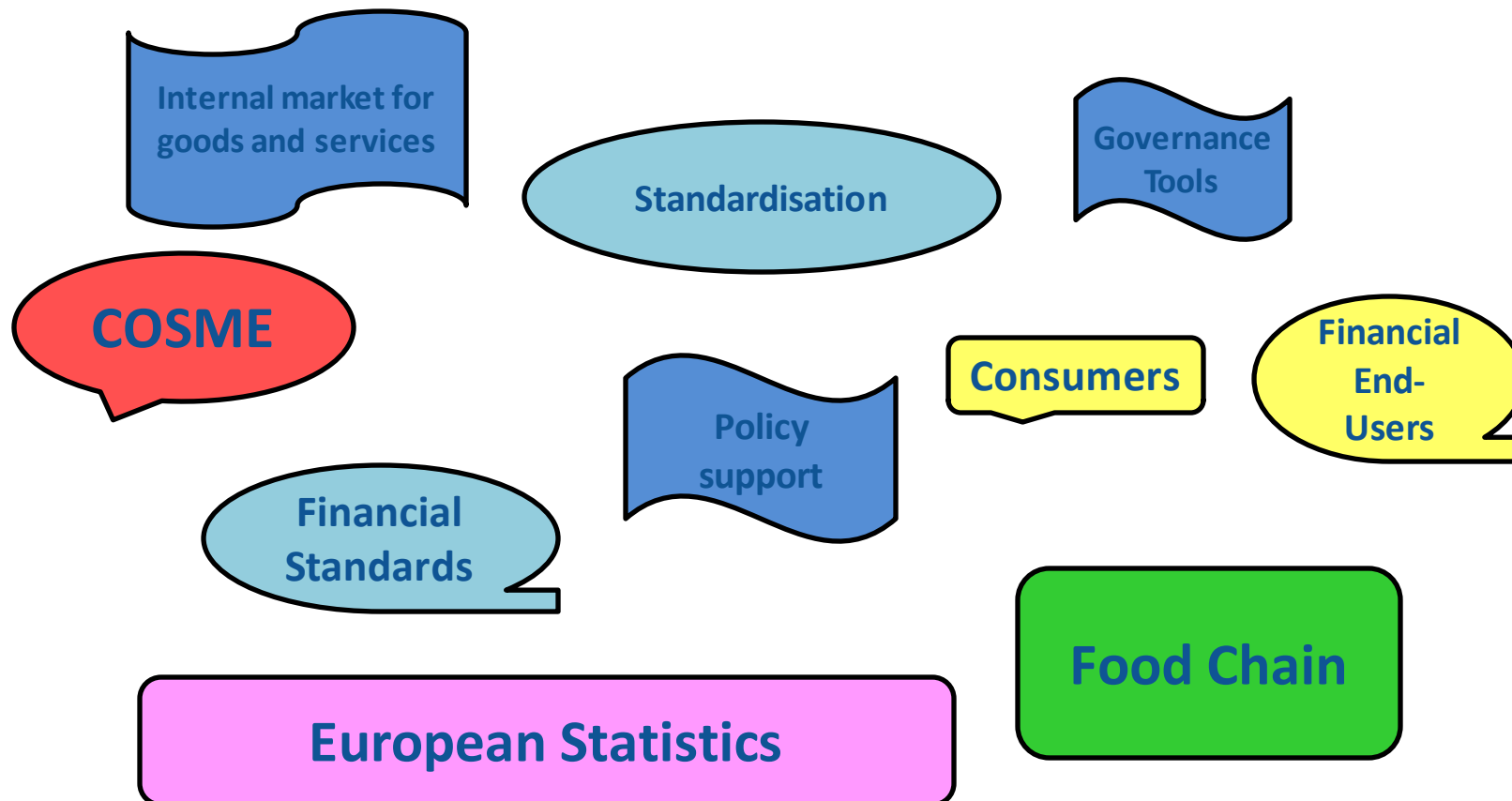
Is the first-ever financial programme to boost the Single Market:

- Focus on economic recovery of each industrial ecosystem

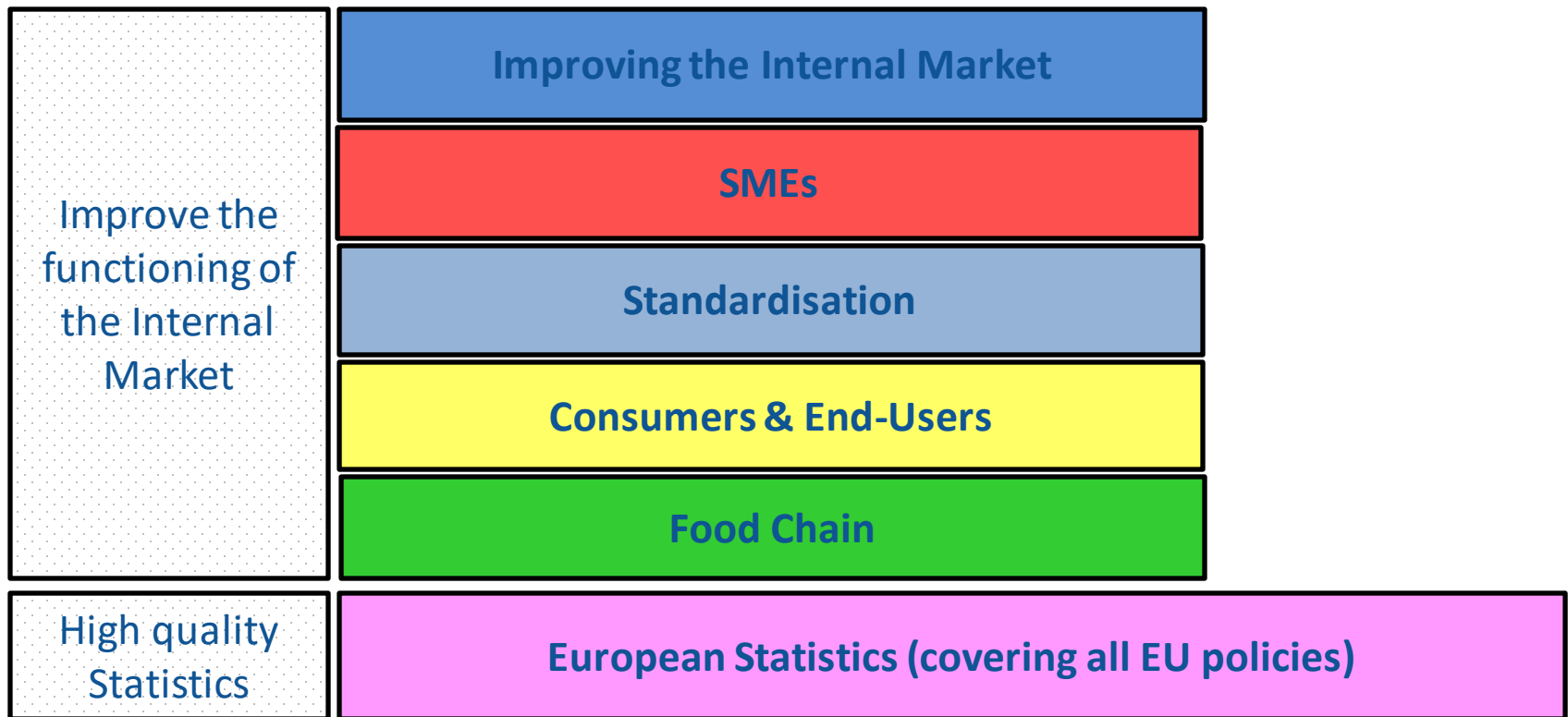
Budget of € 4.2 billion over 2021-2027

Modern and flexible - Integration of various funding programmes and activities in support of the Single Market

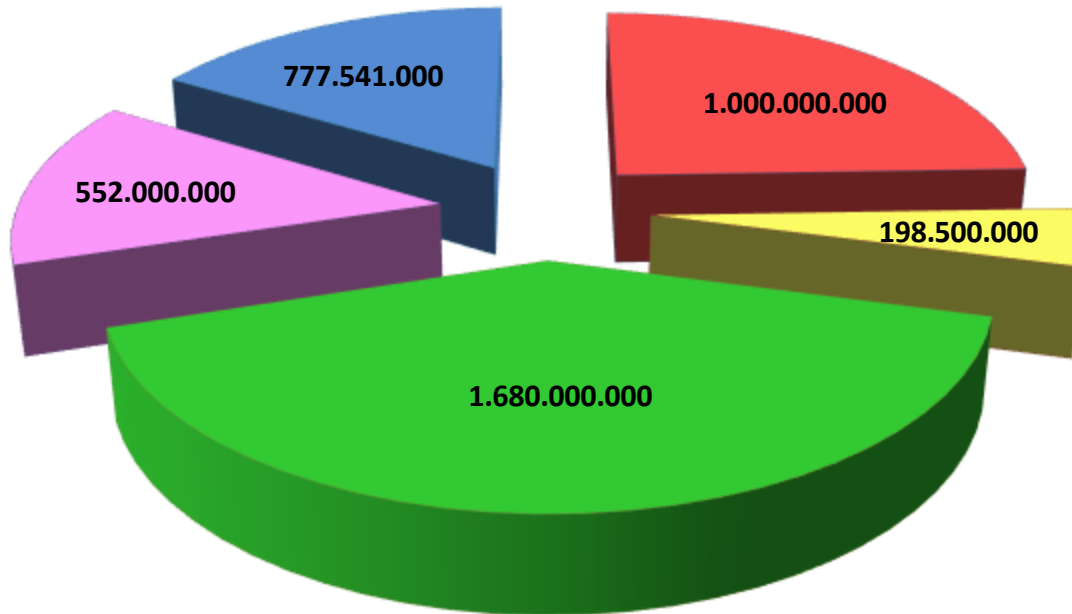


A strengthened governance of the Single Market: targeted actions in various areas

Pillar 1 Making the Internal Market more effective

Activities under the Programme

- Operation and development of the internal market for goods and services
- Internal market governance tools
- Customs and tax policy development support
- Competition policy for a stronger Union in the digital age
(strengthen cooperation, raise stakeholder awareness)



Internal market

Making the internal market more effective, by supporting the development, implementation and enforcement of Union law covering goods and services.

examples

Tools: Single Digital Gateway (online administration services for citizens and companies), Internal Market Information System (information exchange between authorities)

Grants: training of national enforcers/judges

Procurement: studies, analyses, assessments, development of IT systems

- Company and contract law and anti-money laundering
- Implementation and development of internal market for financial services

monitoring financial markets, supporting evidence based policy making, evaluation of legislation..

- Market Surveillance

safe and compliant products on the Single Market, capacity building and reinforced enforcement and cooperation with national authorities, coordinate product inspections at EU level

examples: organise networks, fund joint actions and capacity building – labs, IT tools, digitalisation of market surveillance processes, training of inspectors

Pillar 2 Competitiveness and sustainability of SMEs

Activities under the Programme

- Support to businesses, in particular SMEs
- Facilitate access to markets
- Favourable business environment
- Facilitating the development and growth of businesses
- Competitiveness and sustainability of enterprises and whole sectors of economy (connecting ecosystems, clusters)
- Fostering an entrepreneurial business environment and entrepreneurial culture, including through mentoring and mobility schemes

Enterprise Europe Network to provide an integrated package of advice to SMEs on how to innovate and grow internationally

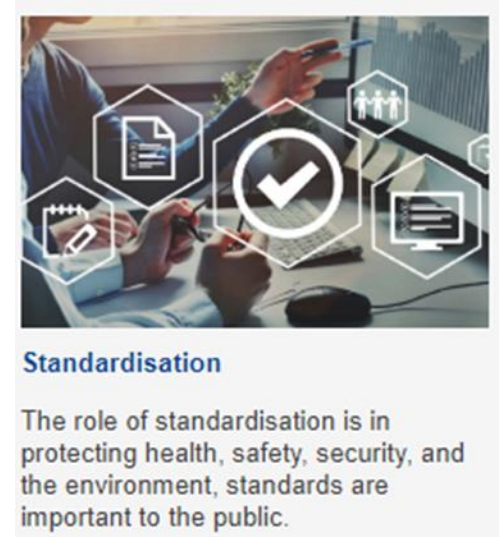

Pillar 3 Ensuring the effective functioning of the internal market through standardisation

Activities under the Programme

- Support to standardisation activities
- Standards in the fields of financial and non financial reporting and auditing



Cooperation between the Commission and European Standardisation Organisations via joint initiatives and action plans

Financial support to organisations that develop European wide standards to ensure that products and services meet an agreed level of quality and safety

Pillar 4 Promoting the interests of consumers & Ensuring high consumer protection and product safety

Activities under the Programme

- Consumer Programme and new Deal for consumers
Make sure products on the market are safe and consumers know the rules, help national authorities to work efficiently together and communicate swiftly

Specific grants for :

- Enhancing the involvement of consumers and other end-users in Union policy-making in financial services
- Promoting a better understanding of the financial sector and commercialised financial products

examples

Safety Gate for dangerous products

Consumer Protection Cooperation network to tackle EU-wide illegal practices (e.g. misleading advertising campaigns)

European Consumer Centres where citizens can solve problems, for example when shopping online

Online Dispute Resolution platform which helps consumers solve disputes out of court



Consumers

Promoting the interests of consumers and ensuring a high level of consumer protection and product safety.

Pillar 5 High level of health and safety for humans, animals and plant throughout the food chain

Activities under the Programme

- Prevent, control and eradicate animal diseases and plant pests
- Support the sustainable food production and consumption
- Improve the effectiveness, efficiency and reliability of official controls
- Support the improvement of animal welfare

examples

Financing of emergency measures

Training for competent authorities in the area of food & feed, animal health & welfare and plants health



Food chain

Developing a strategy in the areas of food law, animal health & welfare and plant health rules. (Health and Digital Executive Agency)

Pillar 6 Producing and communicating high-quality statistics on Europe

Activities under the Programme

- Provide funding to national statistics producers for the production and dissemination of high-quality statistics to monitor the economic, social, environmental and territorial situation
- Providing for evidence-based decision making in the EU and measure impact of EU initiatives

- national statistical institutes
- other national statistical authorities

Statistics

Producing and communicating high-quality statistics on Europe. (Eurostat)

Grants given to national statistical institutes and other national authorities of EU and EFTA countries

Examples: Quality improvement of intra-EU trade data; Population and housing census: geo-referenced data and improved population data; Modernisation and methodological improvements in the area of agricultural, energy, environment, fisheries, forestry, land and transport statistics.

Public procurement

Examples: Provision of statistical data collection, surveys, studies, updated manuals, documentation handbooks, validation of data, indicators and benchmarks; maintenance and development of statistical infrastructure and databases.
