Co.Svi.G. - Managing Organization DTE²V

Co.Svi.G. is a publicly owned consortium, launched in 1988 through an initiative led by the municipalities localized in the Tuscany Traditional Geothermal Area. The Consortium has been established with the objectives of coordinating and fostering the municipalities' joint efforts towards local promotion and development, also supporting the participant organizations for the technical and financial fulfillments necessary to the employment of grants derived from the utilization of the local Geothermal Energy in power generation. Co.Svi.G. currently consists of 21 members, among which 14 municipalities, 2 provinces and Tuscany Region, garnering an important role as the stakeholders' operative branch promoting a model of development truest to the local calling. Amongst the main initiatives led by Co.Svi.G. there are the coordination and management for the Tuscany Region Technology Cluster for Energy and Green Economy (DTE2V), professional training courses for renewable energy and energy efficiency sectors, and the administration of the Tuscany Association for Renewable Energy Food. Thanks to the support given by Tuscany Region, Co.Svi.G. has launched an advanced expertise centre for the study of Geothermal Energy, denominated CEGLab – Larderello Geothermal Energy Excellence Centre Laboratory (www.ceglab.it) and, through an agreement protocol signed between Tuscany Region, Enel Ingegneria e Ricerche, Nuovo Pignone, Ansaldo Energia and CNR, Co.Svi.G. has acquired the SestaLAB experimental area laboratories (www.sestalab.com).
