TRACE-KEI 1st study visit was held in Barcelona on 14th December 2016. All TRACE-KEI partners participated. The choice relied on the leading role that Catalonia region has played in European cluster initiative and development. The government, in fact, has been carrying out a strategic experience on cluster initiatives over the last 22 years driving the regional growth and competitiveness minimizing the economic downturn consequences.
